## Message from Rabbi Muroff: Between Gratitude and Grief

"A man doesn't have time in his life to have time for everything. He doesn't have seasons enough to have a season for every purpose. Ecclesiastes Was wrong about that." -Yehuda Amichai (Noted Israeli Poet)

There really is only so much time.

We have now completed the 5786/2025 fall Jewish holiday cycle. Unlike most years, it is not clear how to feel. Do we languish in the happiness generated by the release of the Hostages? Do we focus on the two-year anniversary of the murders of victims of October 7th?

Both feelings have arrived simultaneously, and both are deserving of our attention. We have been carrying so much for so long that it is hard to know how to walk while holding two intense and traumatic and contradictory feelings.

We know we must hold both as we have done so on many occasions in our lives. Yet this time feels different in a way that is difficult to describe, and still we must move forward.

There is no reason to avoid conflicting sentiments. We must indeed hold both as best we can.

Let's celebrate and acknowledge the release of the hostages. It is indeed miraculous that they have returned. It is what we have been praying for and talking about for two years.

May it be a season of leaning into happiness and gratitude, even while holding grief and disbelief. Let's make the most of each day.


