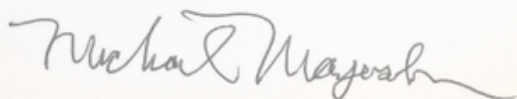

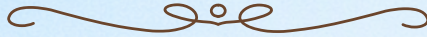
High Holy Days Message from *Rabbi Michael Mayersohn*

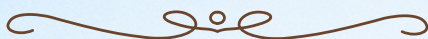

ADMITTANCE CARDS

Tickets are required! See attached form.

RECIPROCITY ARRANGEMENT

Any member who is traveling out of town for the High Holy Days and would like to worship at another synagogue should contact the office at 714.521.6765 or office@tbolm.org as soon as possible to obtain a reciprocity request form

SEATING

Seating is open to everyone on a first come, first served basis. If you will be attending worship services with a large number of people, please be considerate of others and arrive for worship services with most of your group intact.

PARKING

Additional parking is available in the neighborhood behind the Temple and at the Methodist Church. We encourage those with greater mobility to consider parking offsite. Yes, you may drop off your passengers at the Temple, then park. Do not park on the red-painted curbs! You will be ticketed.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Safety and security at all times is of primary concern. In order to facilitate a smooth admittance process, please do not bring backpacks or large bags to services, as all of these items will be subject to a security search. We will have armed security guards at all services. The new fence and gate should help deter any incidences.

YIZKOR BOOKLET

A memorial booklet will be available for the Yom Kippur Yizkor service. To list the name of a loved one in the booklet, please return the Yizkor form no later than September 10th! Late submissions will not be accepted! Loved ones memorialized on our Yahrzeit boards and those who died during the last year are automatically included.

MACHZOR

Each family membership will receive 2 tickets.

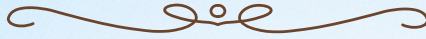
Single membership will receive 1 ticket.

What is תשובה Selichot? Selichot is the Hebrew word which means "forgiveness." It is the theme of the High Holy Days as Jews seek forgiveness for past transgressions against our fellow human beings and against God. The Selichot Service is a symbolic way to begin the process of תשובה **teshuvah**, of turning away from our past mistakes in preparation for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. The Selichot service features readings, prayers and music to help us focus on the themes of the High Holy Days: תשובה teshuvah and תשובה forgiveness.
