Exodus 33:12-34:26

Passover celebrates the birth of the Jewish People. It recalls the Exodus from Egypt which is described in the book of Exodus. By observing the chag/holiday we connect ourselves to God and to the larger Jewish world. On Passover, the author Israel Zangwell wrote, "Jews eat history." During the Seder we partake in the consumption of symbolic foods. They all help us taste the bitterness of slavery via the saltwater of tears, and via the matzah, the dry and difficult days and years of oppression. Ironically, the matzah also represents the promise of redemption. Let's all reflect on the blessing of our redemption and act to bring about redemption for others. -Rabbi Muroff
