Leviticus 21:1-24:23

Lag B'Omer (the 33rd day of the Omer count) is a festive day in Jewish tradition, deeply intertwined with Kabbalah (Jewish mysticism) as it marks the yahrzeit (anniversary of passing) of Rabbi Shimon bar Yochai (Rashbi). He is traditionally credited with revealing the Zohar, the foundational text of Kabbalah. The key mystical connections of Lag B'Omer are: Celebrating Light & Esoteric Wisdom: The bonfires lit on Lag B'Omer symbolize the light of Torah wisdom that Rabbi Shimon bar Yochai revealed. The day is regarded not as a time for mourning his death, but as a celebration of his spiritual achievements, as requested by him. The belief is that the more one is able to see the incredible depths hidden in the Torah, the more one will realize the hidden depths within each person and within oneself. This awareness will enhance the idea of dignity and ignite within each of us a glowing Divine fire. -Rabbi Muroff
