When we were young men we focused on learning how to lead prayers. God was rarely mentioned so our prayer practice was comfortable but rote and empty. In time we began to work to make the world a better place because men need to be active in repairing the world that we were gifted. Today, beyond ritual, men—alongside women—are taught that they are partners with God in Tikkun Olam. This fundamental concept requires Jewish men to actively pursue social justice, charity (tzedakah), and the overall betterment of the world.
