Deuteronomy 16:18-21:9

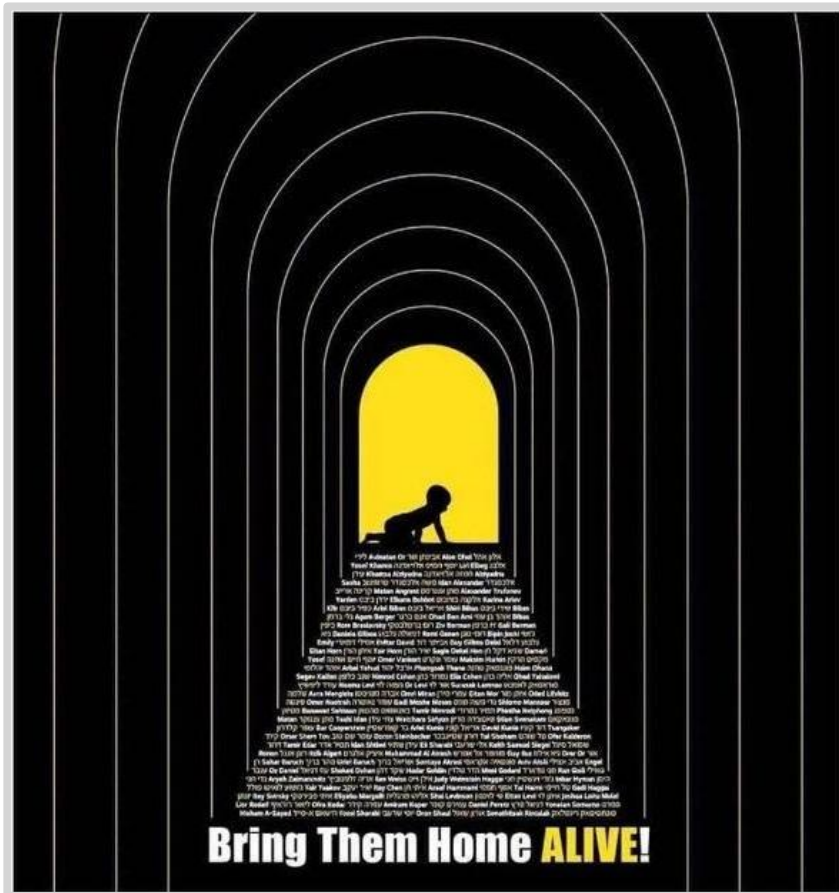
